R Updates from the District Board:

Thank you to the numerous volunteers who support the District. The list includes but not limited to: mow outlots, install and remove docks, provide hospitality, help maintain shoreline, control nuisance pests, work to remove goose eggs, control invasive species. Even picking up garbage on the side of the road.

We are all in this together, so please be respectful of your neighbors. Please do not tie boats to outlot docks. Rather, tie boats and personal watercrafts to trees on the outlots so others can launch from the docks.

Lake Management Update:

We are working on a 5-year Lake Management Plan through lake management company, Wisconsin Lake and Pond Resources. You should have received a post card in the mail inviting you to participate in a survey. These are due May 31, 2021. Survey is found <http://tinyurl.com/Alpine-Lake-Survey>.

2021 key points for vegetation control are maintaining navigational lanes through chemical and mechanical treatment. Chemical treatment dates are pending. Mechanical treatments are scheduled for late June and early August.

We are working on silt removal from the inlet, which was done 15 years ago. Prior to completing, permits need to be filed, the lake level needs to be lowered five feet, and the silt is hauled away from the lake. Boats would need to be removed before the end of September. The silt would be removed during mid-winter. More details to come.

What is Lake Management?

Water covers more than 75% of the Earth, and is one of our most precious resources. How do we take care of the water? First, it starts with you. Maintain your shoreline to avoid erosion. Deep rooted plants near the shore are better than grass. Sandy beaches are great, but when it rains the sand is not a great filter of water running off from your homes. Second, we have a 5-year Lake Management Plan which provides the framework for protection of our resource. The Alpine Lake Protection and Rehabilitation District implements high priority items within the plan. The items are maintaining navigable water, improving fishing opportunities, and controlling aquatic invasive species. We maintain the plan in accordance with the Wisconsin DNR.
